Re: Cyber Security (Security Standards for Smart Devices) Rules 2025

We would like to inform our retail partners of upcoming Australian cyber security regulations affecting the supply of smart and connected (IoT) devices.

From 4 March 2026, the Cyber Security (Security Standards for Smart Devices) Rules 2025 will introduce mandatory cyber security standards for most smart/IoT devices acquired by consumers in Australia. These regulations are intended to enhance consumer protection by improving minimum security standards for connected products.

To comply with these new regulations, Synlan Technology Pte. Ltd (iFlytek Co., Ltd.'s wholly-owned subsidiary), as the manufacturer of Relevant Connectable Devices must meet specific security requirements, specified in the Rules. These include:

- The implementation of unique passwords (if a password is used)
- Establishment of processes for reporting cyber security vulnerabilities
- Disclosure of defined support periods
- Provision of a Statement of Compliance (SoC) for products.

We are pleased to inform you that all Relevant iFLYTEK AINOTE Connectable Devices manufactured from March 2026 will comply with the above security requirements.
